

Pay Per Click Help Without The Hype

If you are new to online advertising, you have probably tried to find pay per click help that does not cost a small fortune. As a beginner, you likely have limited funds, so you want to avoid purchasing an overpriced product that is filled with information that is unlikely to help you anyway.

Most of the advice that you can find is usually misleading or just plain wrong. This is because most of the people giving the advice are trying to get you to buy something from them. So they tell you that the only way to make money with ppc marketing is to use whatever it is that they are selling.

The fact is that there are many different pay per click programs available, and all of them are slightly different. They all have different rules that you need to follow, so finding help that covers every service is virtually impossible.

Nevertheless, you can increase the probability that you will have a profitable campaign if you adhere to some basic principles. Nothing is infallible, of course, but it never hurts to stack the odds in your favor.

For one thing, never bid more than you have to on your keywords. If you have determined that the only way you can make a profit is to pay 10 cents a click, don't let yourself be persuaded to go over that. Trying to outbid your competitors so that you can get the top ad spot will not help you make money.

Another good rule to follow is to always stick with your daily or monthly budget. Once you have determined how much you can afford to spend per day you must stick to your decision. Constantly adjusting this is a common mistake, and it rarely brings good results.

You should run an ad campaign until you get around 500 visits before you decide if it is going to be successful or not. Less than this number won't give you an accurate idea of your sales conversions. It's possible to go for 300 visits without a sale, and yet you might make 3 or 4 sales from the next 100 visits.

On the subject of conversion rates, 100 visits should get you 1 or 2 sales. Less than that and you generally can't make a profit. However, this all depends upon the price of the item that you are selling. Even 1 sale for every 500 clicks can make you money if the product you are selling is expensive enough.

Usually, the best place to find quality pay per click help is from the advertising service you intend to use. A good program will provide detailed tutorials so that you can get the most out of their service. They want you to be successful, so they should provide you with all of the help that you need.
