

Six Tips On Making A Small Washroom Appear Large

Your washroom is your relief center. Normally town houses and apartments do not have more than a single washroom or two. Like the rest of your home you sure want it to look good. To make it appear attractive at the very first glance, add fabric shower curtains that are both bright and impressive in their designs. If you have many family members or visitors using the same bathroom, maintaining it soon becomes a headache. Restroom maintenance mainly in shower curtain rods, water pipes and cabinet area is really important for your bathroom to appear nice and well maintained.

However, maintaining your washroom might not be your current dilemma. Due to the usually small sized homes, the washrooms turn out to be less spacious as well. However, by just working on some areas, you can make your restroom appear large.

The first thing you need to focus on is the walls and ceiling of your washroom. The key is to choose a lighter shade to paint your walls. Also, have your ceiling painted white. If you are using wallpapers for your walls, ensure that they are not patterned with very dark colors. The excellent choice will be the ones having a white base with small light colored pattern.

The next area is the flooring. Again opt for lighter shades for tiles to make the washroom appear bigger. It is advisable to use medium sized six to eight inch ceramic tiles, not bigger than that. Smaller tiles will make your washroom appear even smaller and so would very larger tiles. If you do not wish to change your dark colored tiles, use a light colored rug to cover most of the area.

On the walls you may desire to use full length mirrors that give you a roomy look as soon as you enter. Also the mirrors will enhance the lighting of your washroom, giving reflections that make the washroom exceptionally big. Instead of looking like the walls are closing in on you, they will make the washroom look bigger and roomy.

Lighting also holds an important role in making your washroom look spacious. Use wall scones, mirror lighting and energy efficient bulbs whatever is most appropriate for you. CFL light bulbs are the best choice for this purpose. As they give light that is bright enough to make your washroom appear roomy. Allow sunlight to come as well in daylight hours. Get rid of curtains from the windows for this reason.

Fixtures are the most initial thing you must consider. For the tub, the total area must not be more than sixty by thirty two inches. Use a lower walled bath tub so that it covers lesser area. As for the sink, use the pedestal type. Remove the cabinets beneath. Also omit other extra cabinets all around your restroom. Use glass shelves to put in the place of the cabinets. Also get rid of extra toiletries lying on the floor. Build up a cabinet to put towels and other stuff inside it.

Rather than a traditional door that opens sideways, use a sliding door. These will minimize the space engaged when the door is ajar. You do not have to use really expensive material to get it done. Rather than a wooden door, use any other light material that makes the opening and closing of the door simple for each member of the family.
